We will think and act more Christ-like. We can do it only with the Holy Spirit's help. Jesus was crucified for those sins and now, through faith in him as our Savior, his righteousness becomes our new clothing! Out of love for everything our Savior has done for us and our salvation, we want to change and put on the new self!

The fourth chapter of Ephesians continues listing some of the ways God wants us to act-Don't lie, gossip, slander, fight, steal, or be anger, bitter, or vulgar. Rather, we are to-Be truthful, kind, compassionate, and forgiving, and make yourself useful so you can give to others---just like Jesus!

It's amazing how being in the Word can chase any "blahs" away. God has pointed out that I do have something new. I have a whole new self! How exciting!
